Investment Objective

Fund Commentary *at 31 December 2009*

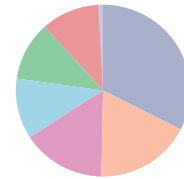
The UK economy contracted during the third quarter but appears poised to expand in the fourth quarter. Inflation remained near the Central Bank's prescribed target, while rates climbed, particularly among shorter maturities as the yield curve flattened. Economic momentum remains positive and for the next three months, housing, retail, credit, and inventory indicators will likely remain favourable. Despite these positive near-term indicators, low household savings and growing fiscal deficits are likely to constrain future growth. The prospect of a hung Parliament would exacerbate fiscal concerns as it would be unlikely that the government would be able to confront fiscal challenges given this structure. We expect that Central Bank policy will likely be influenced to a significant degree by credit, housing, and employment indicators going forward. Risks include a growing lack of credibility in policymakers and that the degree of excess capacity in the economy is smaller than anticipated. Each of these risks, alongside higher import prices, could translate into inflationary outcomes in 2010.
