Investment Objective

The objective of the fund is to provide capital appreciation through investment in a concentrated portfolio of quoted UK securities. The fund's assets will be invested primarily in UK equities but may also be invested in cash-based investments.

Fund Commentary *at 31 December 2009*

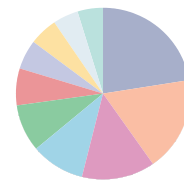
Investors today still have high cash levels which could well be invested into equities in 2010 given the lack of good alternatives and as the global economic recovery becomes more established. The portfolio has returned over 30% this year. Nothing has really changed in the fundamentals to undermine the fund's investment position and this is likely to continue with the broad portfolio strategy that has been in place since the start of the year. This strategy is by no means dependent on a strong recovery in the UK domestic economy. Exposure is focused towards the areas of perceived opportunity, including companies with high and relatively secure dividend yields, companies that are beneficiaries of the "de-stressing" of financial markets and increased savings, and companies with exposure to growth in the global economy and the internet. The portfolio also has exposure to selected banking stocks (largely Lloyds Bank). For the time being the portfolio still appears cheaply valued with improving momentum, so the current strategy is likely to be maintained into 2010.

Portfolio Structure *at 29 January 2010*

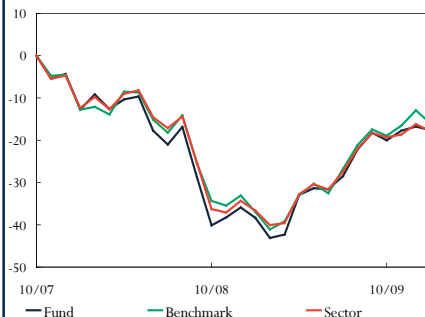
